


Overview

The Employment Standards Tribunal was established on November 1, 1995 under Part 12 of the *Employment Standards Act* (the "Act") as an independent agency with a mandate to conduct appeals of Determinations issued by the Director of Employment Standards and to reconsider decisions made by the Tribunal.








Appeals and Reconsiderations Received and Closed

Fiscal Year




Generally, a case before the Tribunal is decided within 90 days of receipt where the case is decided solely on the basis of written submissions from the parties.




Written Submissions v. Oral Hearings

The Tribunal may decide cases based on either written submissions only or by a combination of an oral hearing and written submissions. Since fiscal year 03/04, Tribunal decisions are based primarily on written submissions only.

The reconsideration requests resulted in the Tribunal, on average, confirming 86% and altering or cancelling 14% of the affected original decisions.
