OVERVIEW


The Employment Standards Tribunal is an independent agency with a mandate to conduct appeals of Determinations issued by the Director of Employment Standards under both the *Employment Standards Act* ("*ESA*") and the *Temporary Foreign Worker Protection Act*¹ and to reconsider decisions made by the Tribunal.

This statistics report covers the period April 1, 2019 through to March 31, 2020 ("FY 19/20").²

APPEALS


The Tribunal received 192 appeals under section 112 of the *ESA* in FY19/20. During this period, thirteen (13) cases were closed as a result of a settlement/withdrawal or for non-compliance with Tribunal directions and one hundred and one (101) cases were closed as a result of a final decision being issued.




The chart below shows a comparison of appeals decisions outcomes in FY18/19 and FY19/20.


RECONSIDERATIONS

The Tribunal received thirty-nine (39) applications for reconsideration under section 116 of the *ESA* in FY19/20. During this period, four (4) cases were closed as a result of a settlement/withdrawal or for non-compliance with Tribunal directions and thirty-five (35) cases were closed as a result of a final decision being issued.
