DECISION

OVERVIEW

This is an appeal by C & C Wood Products Ltd. (“C&C”) pursuant to Section 112 of the *Employment Standards Act* (the “*Act*”) against Determination No. CDET 004132 issued by the Director of the Employment Standards Branch (the “Director”) dated September 30, 1996. The Determination found that C&C had contravened Section 63 (2) of the *Act* and that the amount of \$1,614.17 was owing by C&C to the complainant Stephen M. Maile.

C&C has appealed the Determination alleging that the Director erred in making the Determination.

DECISION

The Employment Standards Tribunal established a hearing into this matter to take place on January 20, 1997 at Quesnel, B.C. The complainant and the Industrial Relations Officer, Cal Mitten, attended. No representative from C&C attended the hearing.

The burden of proof in this proceeding is on WLCP. In the absence of any further representations from that party, I reviewed the submissions received to date. I am unable to conclude that there is any basis for disturbing the Determination.

ORDER

Pursuant to Section 115 of the *Act*, I order that Determination No. CDET 004132 be confirmed
