OVERVIEW

This is an appeal by P.G.G. Holdings Inc. operating as The Nail Connection ("PGG") pursuant to Section 112 of the *Employment Standards Act* (the "Act") from a Determination number ER# 095844 dated December 2, 1999 by the Director of Employment Standards (the "Director").

The Director determined that an employee, Sherr Miller ("Miller") was dismissed from employment with PGG without cause and without compensation. PGG appealed on the basis that Miller quit her position and was therefore not entitled to compensation.

Miller and a delegate for the Director attended for the Hearing at 9:00 am as scheduled. No one appeared on behalf of PGG. We waited until 9:20 am but still no one appeared and I therefore dismissed the appeal. Ms Miller left.

The Director's delegate and the adjudicator remained in the hearing room until 9:40 am but still no-one appeared on behalf of the appellant, PGG.

As the appellant failed to appear the appeal is dismissed and the Determination is therefore confirmed.

ORDER

I order, under section 115 of the *Act*, that the Determination is confirmed.
