OVERVIEW

This is an appeal by Warren Burd Motors (1990) Ltd., (“Burd”), pursuant to Section 112 of the *Employment Standards Act*, (the “Act”), against Determination No. CDET 001783 which was issued by a delegate of the Director of Employment Standards on March 29, 1996. The employer seeks to set aside the Determination claiming they do not owe Gordon Ashley (“Ashley”) any money.

ANALYSIS

During the disclosure of the facts the parties indicated an interest in seeking a resolution to the appeal.

The parties, with the considerable assistance of the Director’s delegate, were able to reach a settlement and exchange formal documents, in which Burd agreed to withdraw it’s appeal.

ORDER

I order, pursuant to Section 115 of the Act, that Determination No. CDET 001783 be cancelled.
